

the dry land earth.**



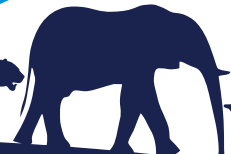




**After this God did another miracle:

created them male and female.” Genesis 1:27








**God had a

forever.**


**Sadly, Adam and Eve did not

would die.**




“Sin came into the world because of what one man did. And with sin came death.”
