- ★ Enoch had an amazing friendship with God. It was so very special. He 'walked with God' (See Genesis 5:23).
- ★ Enoch's life steps were in sync with God. So much so that he:
 - * did what God wanted
 - * followed God's ways
 - * listened to God
 - * loved God
 - * spent lots of time with God
 - * was willing to be used by God

ENOCH'S RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD:

- ★ In the book of Hebrews 11 verse 5, it tells us that 'Enoch pleased God.' Pray and ask the Lord to show you, how you too, can please Him.
- ★ Enoch pleased the Lord by His faith. Hebrews 11:6 says, without faith, you can't please God.
- ★ By his faith, Enoch believed God was real; so, he always wanted to spend lots of time with the Lord.
