Even though Hagar was limited in her freedom, God was still with her:

- ✦ In the wilderness, God met Hagar in the pit of her brokenness, by sending an Angel to speak to her. He encouraged her that she would have a son who she had to call "Ishmael" (God hears), and that she would have many descendants.
- ✦ From this Hagar knew that God was with her. She then returned to Abraham and Sarah.
- ✦ Once Sarah bore her son Isaac, there was a time when Sarah witnessed Ishmael mocking her son. So she went to speak to Abraham, as she was gravely displeased.
- ✦ Abraham packed some bread and water for Hagar and Ishmael, and sent her and her son away for good.
- ✦ This time, Hagar got lost in the wilderness of Beersheba, and all of the water and food ran out. She wept because she thought her son would die there.
- ✦ Once again God came to her aid, by encouraging her that He had not forgotten her, that He would make Ishmael a great nation. He opened her eyes to see a well full of water.

Hagar's Story

- ✦ Hagar was an Egyptian woman.
- ✦ It was customary in those days to have servants. She was the servant to Sarah, who was Abraham's wife.
- ✦ Sarah was well past her child-bearing age. Nevertheless, God had promised Abraham that He would bless him and his decedents.
- ✦ Sarah could not wait, and by the time Abraham was 85 years old, she took matters into her own hands.
- ✦ She asked Abraham to marry Hagar. Sadly, Hagar had no choice in this matter because she was in fact a slave; so Sarah had the right to give her over to Abraham.
- ✦ Hagar therefore became Abraham's second wife, and fell pregnant.
- ✦ Once Hagar was with child, she despised Sarah. Sarah retaliated by treating her harshly. So Hagar fled into the wilderness.
