# Mary's Story

At His feet

## Mary's Story

- Mary was the sister of Martha and Lazarus. She lived in a village called Bethany in Judea, less than two miles from Jerusalem (John 11:18).
- Jesus was good friends with Lazarus, Mary, and Martha. The Word of God shares with us how He loved them (John 11:5).
- When Mary's sister, Martha, welcomed Jesus into their home; Mary spent time sitting at the Lord's feet listening to Him.
- One day Lazarus fell ill, and so Martha and Mary sent word to the Lord about this matter. Jesus knew that God would be glorified through this situation, and prepared Himself to go to them after two days from hearing the news. Sadly by the time Jesus arrived Lazarus had already been dead for four days.
- Once Jesus had arrived, Martha went out to meet Him; but Mary stayed inside their home.
- Later, Martha called her sister secretly and told her that the Master was looking for her, so Mary rushed out to find Jesus. Mary fell down at His feet and wept. Jesus was troubled at heart, and He too wept, and asked Mary to take him to the grave.
- It was there that He asked Martha to remove the large stone covering the cave where Lazarus was laid to rest. When Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead, many of these Jewish people who were mourning with Mary originally, came to radical faith in Jesus (John 11:45)!

You can read more about Mary's story in the Bible in Luke 10:38-42, John 11 and John 12.

## God's Hand in Mary's Life

- Mary had a beautiful friendship with Jesus. She had great reverence for the Lord, and valued His teachings immensely.
- Mary spent a lot of time at the Lord's feet, to listen and learn from Him. She wept at His feet when her brother died; and she even anointed Jesus's feet.
- Six days before the final Passover that Jesus had with His disciples, He went to Bethany. During dinner time, Lazarus sat at the same table with Him; and Mary was led to take a very expensive pound of spikenard ointment, with which she anointed the Lord's feet. She then wiped His feet with her hair (John 12:3, John 11:2).
- Mary carried a valuable life lesson in her heart. She knew how to enjoy and fellowship in the Presence of the Lord.
- Your relationship with God is the most important and most special relationship you will ever have. Be encouraged to take the time to cultivate it and to enjoy it.
