Mary's Story

- God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a small village in the region of Galilee, to speak to Mary. At the time Mary was betrothed to Joseph as they were planning to get married.
- The amazing thing is that God went before Mary to Joseph in a dream, and prepared His heart so that he would know that his wife to be was a faithful woman of virtue; and that he too had an important role to play in fulfilling God's amazing plan for His Son Jesus to come to earth.
- Gabriel explained to Mary that she had found favour in God's sight, and that she would become pregnant with a son, and that she should name Him Jesus.
- Mary was a virgin and not married yet; thus she questioned how all this would be possible. Gabriel explained that the Holy Spirit would come upon her, and that God would do the miracle of putting a baby inside her womb.
- Mary willingly accepted all that Gabriel told her. She said to the angel that she was God's servant and that God's will should be done as such.
- When Mary's cousin, Elizabeth, was six months pregnant with her son, John the Baptist, she received a visit from Mary. Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit, and she spoke and confirmed that the child Mary was carrying was the Lord.

God's Hand in Mary's Life

- God always kept Jesus and His parents safe. After Jesus was born in Bethlehem, an angel of God appeared to Joseph in a dream, and told him to flee to Egypt in order to escape the murderous hands of King Herod.
- God was gentle with Mary's heart, by giving her another son when Jesus was about to die on the cross. Losing a child is such a painful experience. What made this more special, is that Jesus Himself told His mother and John that they would be mother and son. John graciously took Mary into his home from that day on.
